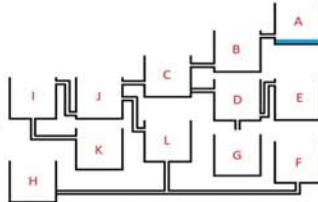
February's Featured Part is a cast iron pump housing that has been precision machined. This iron phosphate casting required a lot of attention to detail. Prior to powder coating, this part must first be processed in our oven to be outgassed. Outgassing the casting is a process we do to assure a good surface finish when complete. The part is then meticulously masked to protect the machined surfaces from the powder coated finish. Finally this casting is powder coated with RAL 3020 Traffic Red Powder.
